On the basis of result of Limited Departmental Competitive Examination held on 18/12/2016 for the vacancy years 2012-13 to 2016-17, declared by DE Branch of the Postal Directorate vide letter no.A-34013/03/2012-DE dated 10/04/2018 and further revised by DE Branch letter no.A-34013/03/2012-DE dated 26/04/2018, the Director General (Posts) in orders No. 9-01/2018-SPG-II (I) dated 06/09/2018, No. 9-01/2018-SPG-II (II) dated 06/09/2018, No. 9-01/2018-SPG-II (III) dated 06/09/2018, No. 9-01/2018-SPG-II (IV) dated 06/09/2018 and No. 9-01/2018-SPG-II (V) dated 06/09/2018 has ordered to appoint the following Inspector line and General line officials to Postal Service Group 'B' Grade on regular basis in the Level-9 (₹ 53,100 - ₹ 1,67,800) of Pay Matrix with effect from the date of assumption of charge and until further orders.

2. The above allotment postings have been recommended by the duly constituted 'Transfer and Placement Committee' in Directorate, in accordance with instructions/guidelines contained in Directorate's letter no.9-23/2014-SPG dated 18/05/2018 and the recommendations are duly approved by the competent authority.

3. Inter-se-seniority of the selected officers will be fixed later on.

4. The vacancies were re-assessed/recalculated for the above mentioned LDCE for the vacancy years from 2012-13 to 2016-17 in pursuance of the judgement dated 10/10/2017 of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in SLP No.24725/2017 (arising out of order dated 10/03/2015 of the Hon'ble CAT, Hyderabad Bench in OA No.554/2013). The Hon'ble Apex Court has directed as following:

"...it is clarified that promotion which has already been given may not be disturbed but the respondents will be entitled to be considered against any future vacancies by making suitable adjustment in future in accordance with the impugned judgement."

Accordingly, the officers promoted above will get seniority of future vacancies which occurred during the vacancy year against which they were selected and onwards.

5. The above promotion will subject to final outcome of court cases as mentioned in the result of LDCE issued vide Directorate's letter no.A-34013/03/2012-DE dated 10/04/2018 and 26/04/2018.

6. The above promotion is also subject to:

- (e) directions passed by the Hon'ble CAT, Bangalore Bench vide orders dated 21/08/2018 in OAs no.467/2018, 575/2018 and no.761/2018.
- (f) outcome in OA no.387/2018 filed before the Hon'ble CAT, Ernakulam Bench
- (g) outcome in OA no.507/2018 filed before the Hon'ble CAT, Chandigarh Bench
- (H) outcome in OA no.249/2018 filed before the Hon'ble CAT, Jaipur Bench

7. In accordance with DoP&T OM No.36012/11/2016-Estt(Res-I) (Pt-III) dated 15/06/2018 on the subject "*implementation of interim orders/directions in Special Leave to Appeal (C) No.30621/2011 arising out of final judgement and order dated 15/07/2011 in CWP No.13218/2009 passed by the Hon'ble Court of Punjab & Haryana and Special Leave to Appeal (C) 31288/2017 arising out of Hon'ble Delhi High Court judgement dated 23/08/2017 and other related court cases - regarding*", the promotion shall be subject to further orders which may be passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

8. GENERAL CONDITIONS:-

- (i) Re-allotment requests, if any, shall not be entertained before completion of tenure as envisaged in Directorate's letter no.9-23/2014-SPG dated 18/05/2018.
- (ii) Appointment is conditional to the officer's placement/joining in the designated Circles.
- (iii) It is the officer's responsibility to send a copy of the charge report on assumption of charge on the promoted post to Section Officer(SPG-II), Postal Directorate, New Delhi for information.
- (iv) Officers should be relieved within 15 days from the date of Directorate's orders cited in para 1.
- (v) In case of officer, who is not willing to accept his/her promotion, his/her declination letter writing should be received in Directorate within 30 days from the date of Directorate's orders cited in para 1. Non-assumption of charge after 30 days, without any valid reason will attract appropriate action against the officer, viz deemed declination of promotion.

9. VIGILANCE / DISCIPLINARY CASE, IF ANY:

In case any vig./disc. case, of the type referred to in O.M. No. 22011/2/86-Estt (A) dated 12.01.88 from DOP&T circulated vide Directorate's memo no. 25-19/88-SPG dated 04.05.88 (subsequently) revised vide DOP&T memo No. 22011/4/91-Estt (A) dated 14.09.92 circulated vide Directorate's memo no. 25-19/88-SPG dated 13.10.92 is pending against the officials, they should not be relieved for posting without obtaining specific orders from this office. The promotion of the official should not be withheld on the mere ground that disciplinary action is contemplated, except the circumstances when the officer is under suspension or a charge sheet has been issued to the official or prosecution for a criminal charge is pending against the official. The official against whom any punishment is current except censure and recovery of money, they should not be promoted before expiry of currency of punishment. A report in this regard may be submitted immediately.

It is the responsibility of the controlling authorities concerned to ensure that no vigilance/disciplinary case is pending against the officers, before relieving them on their promotion to PS Group 'B' cadre.

10. PROBATION PERIOD :

The officials who have been promoted to the Postal Service Group 'B' will be on probation for two years and then their suitability to hold this post will be adjudged on completion of two years of probation. If any official proceeds on leave for a period exceeding 30 days during this period, the probation period will be extended depending upon the period of leave.

11. TRAINING :

The official will be directly promoted to Postal Service Group 'B' without any training for the present. However they will have to undergo the prescribed training as and when notified by Director, RAKNPA, Ghaziabad.

12. OPTION FOR FIXATION OF PAY :

If the officer who wishes to give option for choosing date for fixation of pay under FR-22(l)(a)(1) should do so within one month from the date of assumption of charge on promotion.

13. Officers may be relieved on time so as to join the new post.
